Business

Brett Herbert, Regional Bowls Manager - Northern and Western SA

Began his role with Bowls Australia as the Regional Bowls Manager (RBM) on the 8th of August 2022. Brett explained how there are 2 RBM's in SA with Daniel Cocks being the other one who looks after Metro and Southeast. Brett's area is Northern and Western South Australia. In Brett's region there are 110 clubs in 14 associations. Five of those regions are country and this includes:

R2 Yorke Peninsula

R4 North Eastern Riverland (Freeling to Renmark) and Broken Hill

R8 Lower North Wasleys to Hallett

R3 Upper North Gulnare to Hawker includes Whyalla and Port Augusta

R5 Eyre Peninsula Ceduna

The main purpose of the RBM is to assist clubs in as many ways as possible. This includes

- Identifying opportunities to grow participation and membership
- Optimizing venue usage and diversifying revenue streams
- Support with planning, including business, strategic and financial
- Offering training and assistance across a range of areas such as grants, websites and social media
- Provide support with governance, facility projects and local government relations

Brett advised that he plans to mee with all clubs in his region over the next 12 months and encouraged for any club and/or person to reach out to him, if they have anything specific, they would like to discuss.
